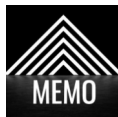
On our website you can make an online gift and you will find all of our bank details to enable you to make a direct payment or set up a regular gift. There are also details about how to leave a gift to us in your Will.

Our big news to share in this, our 100th newsletter, is that we have had more than two million visitors to our website, Chatnow.org.

People have come from all over the world looking for help with struggles, wanting answers to spiritual questions, and trying to find hope - and have found Chatnow.

Every page on our site encourages visitors to "Chat with a Christian", and on our homepage, the invitation is simply:

An amazing 20% of our visitor click to chat. That's currently 413,000 people

To put this in perspective, most websites see just 2-5% of visitors take an action, with high performing sites maybe reaching 5-10%. Chatnow.org is seeing over 20% of visitors choosing to click on our chat button because God is clearly drawing people to us, whose lives He is already at work in!

I have a severe illness and I'm afraid I may be passing soon. I have never been a Christian and I have committed a lot of sins. I wanted a space to repent for them, so hopefully Jesus would see if he is out there.

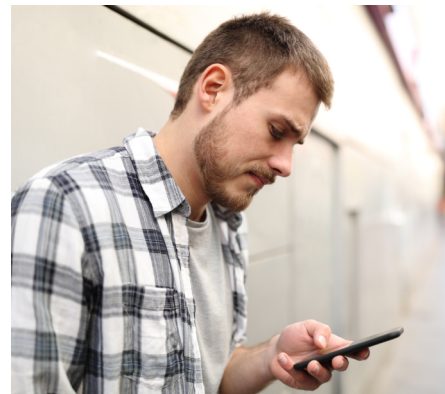
I am grateful I get to talk with you today. I know how hard it is to get a severe diagnosis. We have had to deal with some of that with our son. I'd love to share with you about God how much God loves you.

Please feel free

So you've shared that you have committed sin. We are all sinners who don't live up to the mark that is set forth before us. But, I want to share with you that we don't believe that God saves us because of the good works we do. Jesus loves you. He wants a relationship with you.

It's hard. I lived a cruel life. I want to believe in Jesus, because I want to believe in goodness and justice, but I have never seen any. I want to be saved. What if I try my best to place my faith in him, but my heart is still doubtful and angry, no matter how hard I try. Do I still go to hell?

Jesus loves you and offers you forgiveness. He lived a life we could never live (perfect and sinless) and died a death that we deserved. He rose three days later, defeating death. Jesus offers us this free gift of salvation by grace through Faith. There is nothing we can do to earn it. If you haven't, I hope you will place your faith in Him.



I will say it: I place my faith in Jesus. I want him to be real. I want to be saved. I want to accept him and be Saved. But I can't honestly say I actually believe it. Just that I really want to believe it.

I understand that the life you've lived can make you skeptical of saving faith in Jesus. Only you and the Lord know if you have really believed in Him as your Lord and Savior. May I ask you what is the hard part for you to believe?



I just don't have it in me. I don't want to explain. I am here to ask for forgiveness, not to explain why I find it so hard to believe. I just want to be saved and be forgiven. I want to accept Jesus. I mean that from the bottom of my heart.

I believe you. Even if this diagnosis is the thing that brought you there. Jesus loves you and desires a relationship with you. One of my favourite verses is Mark 9:24 that says "Lord, I believe but help my unbelief." No one has perfect faith and even in your doubt He can and will meet you there.

I wasn't so bad you know. I never hurt anyone. I never committed a crime. I worked with autistic children. I was for the most part kind to people. I was definitely not evil. Maybe I was even good. My sins were many, as is the case for all of us. No one can never sin. I was very, very blasphemous, for instance. I was mad at God for the hard life I lived. I even tried going to church once or twice. I just wasn't very religious.

I can tell you He is real and loves you, and He is pursuing you, and that's what you are experiencing. Religion does not save us but trusting Jesus does. You can place your faith in the one who created you!

I accept Jesus if the door is still open. I can't say I believe without a doubt, but I believe he is possible and I want to be saved.
